Chapter 11 The Gifts Of Healing

Mark 1:40-42 NASB And a man with leprosy came to Jesus, imploring Him and kneeling down, and saying to Him, "If You are willing, You can make me clean." 41Moved with compassion, Jesus reached out with His hand and touched him, and said to him, "I am willing; be cleansed." 42And immediately the leprosy left him, and he was cleansed.

Matt 28:20 teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

Exo 23:25 You shall serve the LORD your God, and he will bless your bread and your water, and I will take sickness away from among you.

Deu 7:15 And the LORD will take away from you all sickness, and none of the evil diseases of Egypt, which you knew, will he inflict on you, but he will lay them on all who hate you.

James 5:15 And the prayer of faith will save the one who is sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven.

Psa 147:3 He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds.

Isa 61:1-3 The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me, because the LORD has anointed me to bring good news to the poor; he has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound; 2to proclaim the year of the LORD's favor, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all who mourn; 3to grant to those who mourn in Zion— to give them a beautiful headdress instead of ashes, the oil of gladness instead of mourning, the garment of praise instead of a faint spirit; that they may be called oaks of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he may be glorified.

Jer 3:22 "Return, O faithless sons; I will heal your faithlessness." "Behold, we come to you, for you are the LORD our God.

Hos 14:4 I will heal their apostasy; I will love them freely, for my anger has turned from them.

Mark 16:18 NASB And behold, I am sending the promise of my Father upon you. But stay in the city until you are clothed with power from on high."

Mark 8:23-25 And he took the blind man by the hand and led him out of the village, and when he had spit on his eyes and laid his hands on him, he asked him, "Do you see anything?" 24And he looked up and said, "I see people, but they look like trees, walking." 25Then Jesus laid his hands on his eyes again; and he opened his eyes, his sight was restored, and he saw everything clearly

John 5:14 NKJV Afterward Jesus found him in the temple, and said to him, "See, you have been made well. Sin no more, lest a worse thing come upon you.

Matt 12:45 Then it goes and brings with it seven other spirits more evil than itself, and they enter and dwell there, and the last state of that person is worse than the first. So also will it be with this evil generation."

Luke 5:31 And Jesus answered them, "Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick.

Luke 24:49 And behold, I am sending the promise of my Father upon you. But stay in the city until you are clothed with power from on high."

Matt 9:22 Jesus turned, and seeing her he said, "Take heart, daughter; your faith has made you well." And instantly the woman was made well.

Mark 5:34 And he said to her, "Daughter, your faith has made you well; go in peace, and be healed of your disease."

Luke 8:48 And he said to her, "Daughter, your faith has made you well; go in peace."

Matt 17:15-20 said, "Lord, have mercy on my son, for he has seizures and he suffers terribly. For often he falls into the fire, and often into the water. 16And I brought him to your disciples, and they could not heal him." 17And Jesus answered, "O faithless and twisted generation, how long am I to be with you? How long am I to bear with you? Bring him here to me." 18And Jesus rebuked the demon, and it came out of him, and the boy was healed instantly. 19Then the disciples came to Jesus privately and said, "Why could we not cast it out?" 20He said to them, "Because of your little faith. For truly, I say to you, if you have faith like a grain of mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move, and nothing will be impossible for you."

Matt 13:58 And he did not do many mighty works there, because of their unbelief.

Mark 6:5,6 And he could do no mighty work there, except that he laid his hands on a few sick people and healed them. 6And he marveled because of their unbelief. And he went about among the villages teaching.

Gen 22:14 So Abraham called the name of that place, "The LORD will provide"; as it is said to this day, "On the mount of the LORD it shall be provided."

Exo 17:15 And Moses built an altar and called the name of it, The LORD Is My Banner,

Jer 23:5,6 "Behold, the days are coming, declares the LORD, when I will raise up for David a righteous Branch, and he shall reign as king and deal wisely, and shall execute justice and righteousness in the land. 6In his days Judah will be saved, and Israel will dwell securely. And this is the name by which he will be called: 'The LORD is our righteousness.'

Psa 23:1 The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.

Exo 40:35 And Moses was not able to enter the tent of meeting because the cloud settled on it, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle.

Exo 15:26 saying, "If you will diligently listen to the voice of the LORD your God, and do that which is right in his eyes, and give ear to his commandments and keep all his statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you that I put on the Egyptians, for I am the LORD, your healer."

Psa 103:3 who forgives all your iniquity, who heals all your diseases,

John 1:18 No one has ever seen God; the only God, who is at the Father's side, he has made him known.

Heb 10:7 Then I said, 'Behold, I have come to do your will, O God, as it is written of me in the scroll of the book."

Mark 1:41 Moved with pity, he stretched out his hand and touched him and said to him, "I will; be clean."

Matt 4:24 So his fame spread throughout all Syria, and they brought him all the sick, those afflicted with various diseases and pains, those oppressed by demons, those having seizures, and paralytics, and he healed them.

Matt 8:16 That evening they brought to him many who were oppressed by demons, and he cast out the spirits with a word and healed all who were sick.

Matt 12:15 Jesus, aware of this, withdrew from there. And many followed him, and he healed them all

Matt 12:22 Then a demon-oppressed man who was blind and mute was brought to him, and he healed him, so that the man spoke and saw.

Matt 14:14 When he went ashore he saw a great crowd, and he had compassion on them and healed their sick.

Matt 14:36 and implored him that they might only touch the fringe of his garment. And as many as touched it were made well.

Matt 15:30 And great crowds came to him, bringing with them the lame, the blind, the crippled, the mute, and many others, and they put them at his feet, and he healed them,

Matt 19:2 And large crowds followed him, and he healed them there.

Matt 21:14 And the blind and the lame came to him in the temple, and he healed them.

Luke 4:40 Now when the sun was setting, all those who had any who were sick with various diseases brought them to him, and he laid his hands on every one of them and healed them.

Luke 8:50 But Jesus on hearing this answered him, "Do not fear; only believe, and she will be well."

Mark 16:18 they will pick up serpents with their hands; and if they drink any deadly poison, it will not hurt them; they will lay their hands on the sick, and they will recover."

Luke 9:1,2 And he called the twelve together and gave them power and authority over all demons and to cure diseases, 2 and he sent them out to proclaim the kingdom of God and to heal.

Luke 9:6 And they departed and went through the villages, preaching the gospel and healing everywhere.

Luke 10:8,9 Whenever you enter a town and they receive you, eat what is set before you. 9Heal the sick in it and say to them, 'The kingdom of God has come near to you.'

John 14:12 Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever believes in me will also do the works that I do; and greater works than these will he do, because I am going to the Father.

Heb 13:8 Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.
